TERMS

Lessons run from September to mid June

- Fall Term: September 6th to December 20th
- Winter Term: January 9th to March 10th
- Spring Term: March 21st to June 16th
- * Summer Term (optional): July 3rd to August 25th

NO LESSONS

- Truth and Reconciliation Day: September 30th
- Thanksgiving Day: October 10th
- Rememberance Day: November 11th
- Winter Break: December 21st to January 6th
- March Break: March 13th to March 17th
- Good Friday: April 7th and Orthodox Good Friday: April 14th
- Easter Monday: April 10th

ATTENDANCE

- Regular attendance is essential to make progress.
- Lessons are offered in an online format through Zoom or Google Meets.

MISSED LESSONS

- Lessons missed by the student for any reason will be made up according to the teacher's discretion, provided that 24-hour notice has been given. If a lesson can't be rescheduled, make-up credit will be offered.
- If I need to cancel the lesson, a make-up lesson will be offered, or the student will be given a make-up credit.
- Lateness to the lesson will not be made up. Late arrival to the lesson is still counted towards lesson time, and will be charged as a full lesson accordingly.
- No refunds, credits or make-ups will be offered for lessons missed without notice. Missed lessons
 without notice will be forfeited.
- Notice should be given as soon as possible.

TUITION

• Lesson fee is based on an hourly rate. Monthly payment depends on the number of lessons in a given month. Please see the rate below.

PAYMENTS

Payments are billed monthly. They are due and payable in advance upon receiving an invoice at the beginning of each month, no later than the 7th day of the month. Late fee of \$25 will be applied. E-transfer and PayPal are accepted.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

- Registration fee of \$25 to reserve a spot.
- It is a student's responsibility to print emailed materials, purchase books, pay fees for festivals, competitions and/or exams.
- I may collect additional charges to cover the renting costs for recitals (if applicable).
- There will be a monthly charge of \$4 per student for the subscription to SproutBeat which is an online platform that provides digital theory resources. This is optional and can be cancelled at any time. There will be a trial period offered, and afterwards the students can decide if they want to subscribe.

LESSON TERMINATION

- Students have the flexibility to start and end lessons at any point of the school year.
- Two weeks notice is required.

The teacher reserves the right to discontinue lessons should any issues arrise, and will give a month's notice.

PRACTICE EXPECTATIONS

- A daily practice routine is the key to success and progress in music. For younger students parents play an important role in establishing a good practice routine. Create a quiet space and schedule a piano practice session every day.
- Students need to prepare for every lesson by following their weekly assignments. They need to have their pencils, eraser, sheet music, notebook and manuscript paper ready before the lesson starts.
- All students need to have an instrument at home, either a tuned acoustic piano or a digital piano with 88key weighted action and proper foot pedals.
- Purchasing a metronome is highly recommended. It is a valuable tool in daily practice. Optionally, students can use an online metronome or downloadable metronome apps.
